In a recent Cape Argus article by Nontando Mposo, Gary van Wyk shares the story of his journey to becoming a photographer. Van Wyk, who is now collaborating on the third season of Adrian Steirn's <u>21 lcons</u>, says that Steirn is not the first great photographer to inspire him. He first got the idea to become a photographer on a beach next to the Caribbean Sea when he saw a photographer preparing to capture an image of a particularly amazing sunset.

George Hallett was another important influence in Van Wyk's development. Hallett, who is the author of Moving in Time: Images of Life in a Democratic South Africa, has been called one of South Africa's "finest living black photographers" Read the article:

"I started my internship at the Cape Argus in 2003. I was supposed to be there for only two days but I stayed for five years. When Cape Town photographer George Hallett introduced us to documentary photography, I jumped at it ... it just made sense to me," he says. "It was the best training and experience I could have asked for. I learnt how to shoot under pressure. It was the best way of learning ... the best thing that ever

happened to me.
